







Include Roman numerals. <p><u>Shield/Helmet Artefact</u> Research, design and make a shield or a helmet that the Roman Army could have used/wore in a battle. Use card, paper, and craft materials and paint to decorate. <p><u>Roman Bulla</u> A bulla was a kind of amulet that Roman children wore to protect them until they reached adulthood. A bulla could have been an elaborate gold locket like pendant, or just a simple cloth bag.
